■ Expanded Discussions and Level-Based Sessions



This year, AMWC Japan will feature its largest-ever scale, with more than 120 speakers from 38 countries presenting across five lecture halls.

1. Enhanced discussion sessions This year will feature numerous sessions that include discussions. Through active exchanges of opinions among doctors from diverse backgrounds, the event aims to deliver more interactive and practical insights.

2. Advanced and beginner-level courses

On the morning of the second day, sessions on combination treatments and injection treatments will be divided into two tracks—one for experienced, advanced practitioners and one for younger doctors considering opening their own practice—allowing attendees to choose the program best suited to their experience and level.



3. Sessions from a surgical perspective On the second day, numerous sessions centered on surgeons are planned. In addition to approaches to age-related changes in the upper and lower eyelids, the sessions will also cover the fundamentals of anatomy in detail.

■ Program (Excerpt)

Over the two-day event, 43 programs will be held, including corporate sessions. Numerous lectures rarely heard in Japan will be presented by speakers from many countries, including Europe and South Korea, which are leading the field of aesthetic medicine.

J Beauty vs. K Beauty — Differences in Trends, Techniques, and Patient Needs —

Many speakers from South Korea, a leading nation in aesthetic medicine, will once again take part this year. On the first day in particular, a discussion-style "beauty battle" titled "J Beauty vs. K Beauty" will be held between Japanese and Korean physicians on aesthetic medicine. Leading doctors in the field, together with younger physicians, will exchange views on current trends, patient requests, and the treatments doctors use to address them with the latest techniques.

Regenerative Medicine × Beauty = Regenerative Aesthetics On the first day, Hall 3 will be dedicated entirely to sessions on regenerative medicine. Professionals from seven countries—Japan, the United States, Mexico, Malaysia, France, China, and Poland—will gather to discuss how regenerative medicine relates to aesthetics, sharing the situation in each country and the future outlook for aesthetic medicine.
