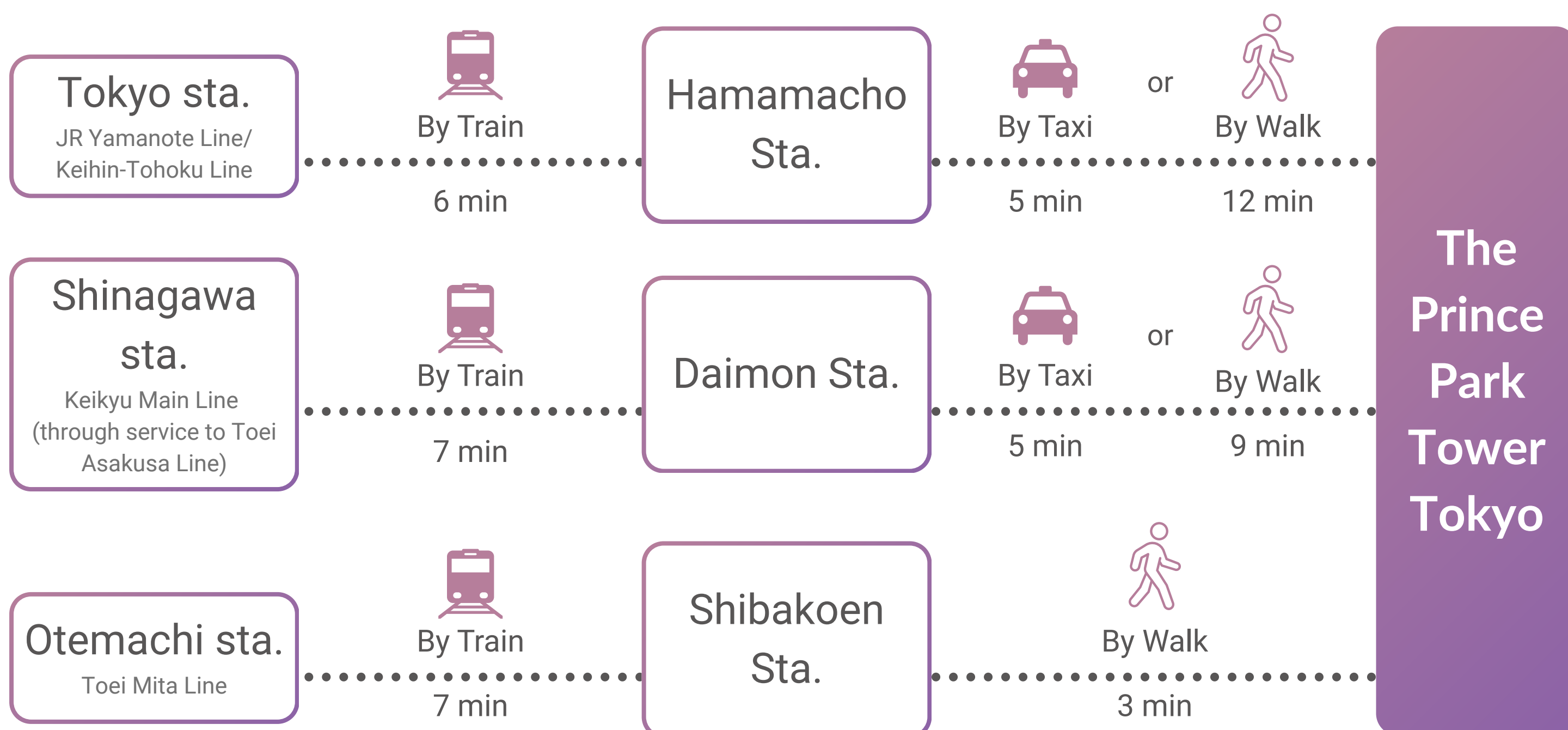

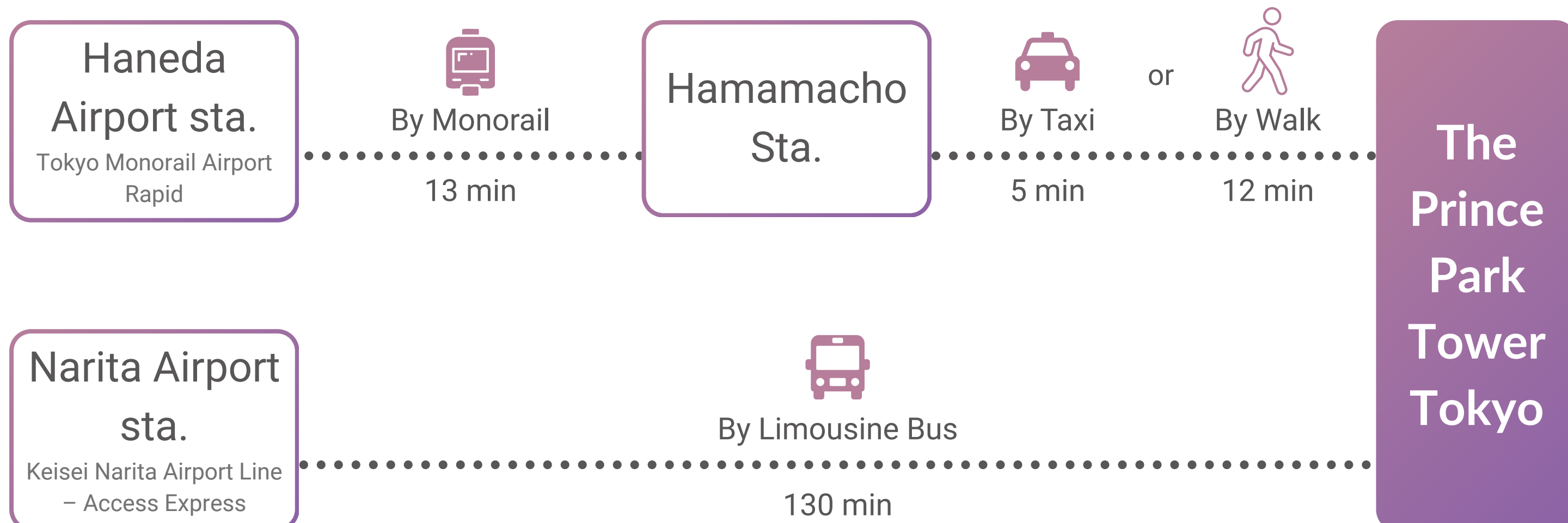

## Around Venue

### Tokyo Tower

- Tokyo Tower is one of Tokyo's most famous landmarks and a symbol of the city.
- You can enjoy panoramic views of Tokyo from its observation decks, with clear autumn skies making the scenery even more impressive.
- At night, the illuminated tower creates a beautiful and memorable city view.

### Zojouji Temple

- Zojouji Temple is a historic temple closely tied to the Tokugawa family, offering a calm space in the middle of the city.
- The iconic Sangedatsumon Gate, built in 1622, is Tokyo's oldest wooden structure.
- Visitors can enjoy a peaceful atmosphere and a striking contrast between traditional temple grounds and the modern skyline.

## Around Roppongi

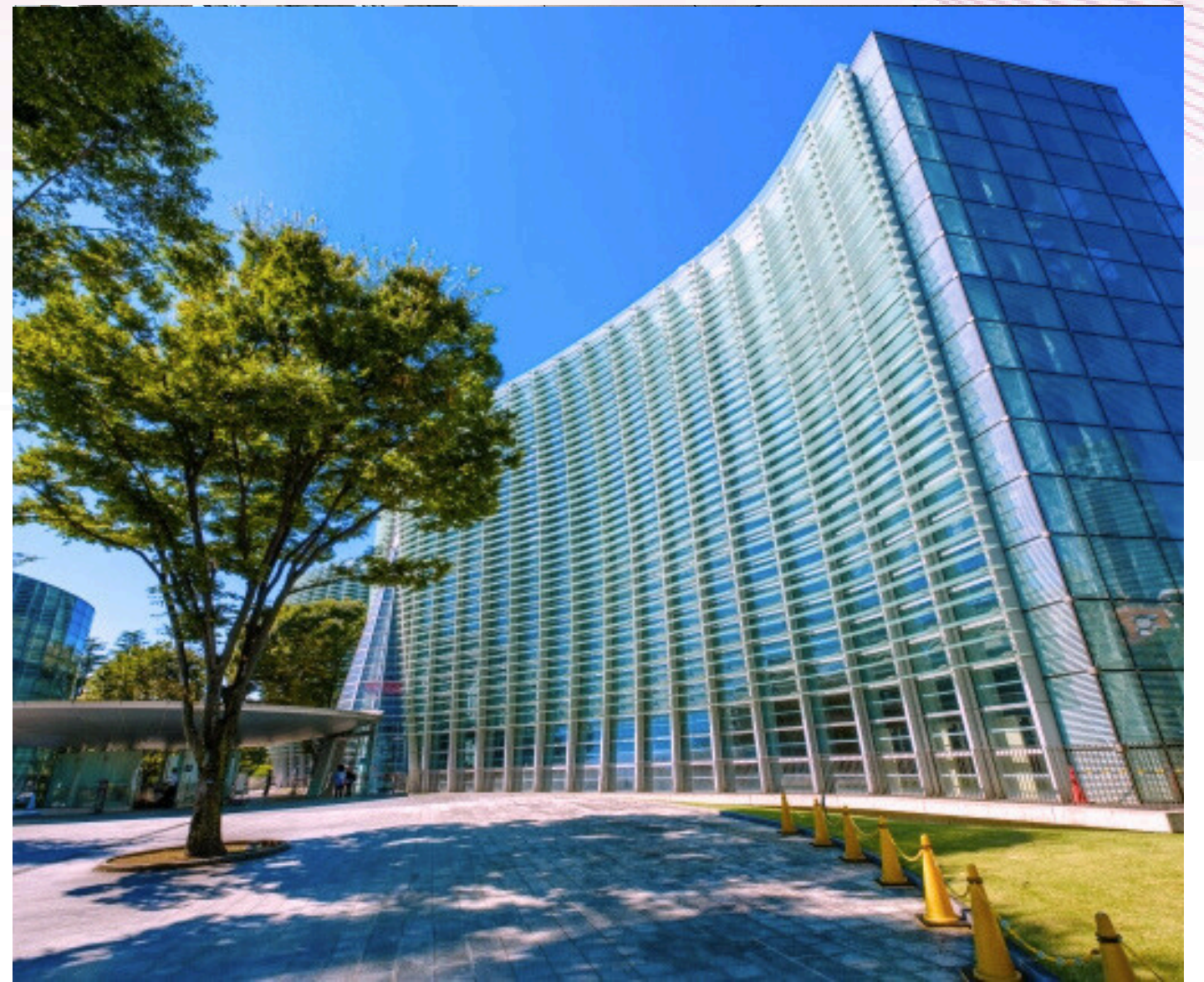
### The National Art Center

## Around Akasaka

### ASAKUSA, SENSOUJI

- Senso-ji Temple, the oldest temple in Tokyo, is a must-see sightseeing spot in Tokyo.
- The area around the temple preserves the atmosphere of old Edo (Tokyo)
- Stroll along Nakamise Street to enjoy great food (Ten-don), dessert (Ningyo-yaki), and shop for traditional Japanese souvenirs (fans, yukata).
